Special Award (may not be awarded every year)	For truly outstanding achievement deserving recognition by Lincolnshire LTA

Who can nominate? - Any person, club or sports organisation. Can I nominate myself? - Yes

How do I nominate? - Nominations must be emailed to lincstennis@gmail.com or posted to 46 Woodfield Avenue, Lincoln LN6 0LH using the approved nomination form. Please use one form for each nomination. Nominations close at midnight on Sunday 18th December 2016.

Can I nominate the same person for more than one award? - Yes

How do I nominate someone in an Aegon British Tennis Awards category – you need to follow the link www.lta.org.uk/britishtennisawards

What happens in the nomination process? – All nominees for both sets of awards will be formally made aware by Lincs LTA of their nomination once entries have closed. A panel of judges will meet early in 2017 to decide on the winners having been provided with all the nomination information which will also be checked for accuracy. Winners will be announced on the night of the awards ceremony.

What do winners & nominees receive? – All winners of Aegon British and Lincolnshire Tennis awards receive a personalised engraved glass plaque and a certificate. All nominees receive a certificate. All are encouraged to attend the ceremony to receive the thanks of the Lincolnshire tennis family.

When and where will the Annual Awards & Presentation Ceremony take place? – The Awards & Presentations Ceremony will be held from 6pm (Juniors) 7pm (Adults) on Saturday 25th March 2017 at The Showroom, Tritton Road, Lincoln, LN6 7QY.
