Baby Learning Together - Baby Learning Together offers a variety of activities as well as a Talk Time, songs and stories to support babies' early development, by building their confidence as they learn to explore.

Learning Together Toddlers - Learning together offers a variety of activities as well as a Talk Time, songs and stories to support children's development, by building their confidence as they learn to explore.

Big Cook Little Cook - Children and parents can work together to prepare and cook a nutritious meal. As well as promoting a healthy lifestyle, children will enjoy cooking alongside their parent /carer while developing their motor skills. Term time only

Coffee & Play - A group run by parents and carers, focusing on child led play. Mid-morning snack provided. Come and join in the singing and dancing. Suitable for 0-5 years.

Learning Through Play - This drop in session provides a variety of activities for children to explore supporting children's changing needs and interests, the session offers an opportunity for parents, carers and children to discover and explore a wide range of play activities together, encouraging children's independence, confidence and social skills.

Little Explorers - A sensory and messy play session providing materials of differing textures, temperatures and consistencies for children to explore, supporting their development and growing confidence.

Little Monkeys - Our parent volunteer Sarah runs this community session for parents with children aged 0-5 years. They offer play, singing and snacks. £1 per family. Term time only.

BreastStart Breastfeeding Group - Come and join us in a relaxed friendly environment to chat and meet other breastfeeding mums. There is a member of the health team available.

Health Visitor Health Clinic - See a member of your local health team to have an assessment of your child's developmental milestones and address any concerns that you may have. Appointments are sent out directly by the Health Visiting Team or you can contact them on: 01522 843000

Top Tips for Babies - Group session run by a Family Health Worker covering: feeding, immunisations guidelines, oral health, healthy living, accident prevention, minor illnesses and much more!

Midwife Clinic - The midwife runs a clinic at the centre on a Monday and Thursday by appointment only. To contact the midwives, please call 01507 631210

Sensory Room Drop-in @ Binbrook Children's Centre - The sensory room will be designed to develop babies' senses such as feel, vision, sound and smell through lighting, music and objects. Come and explore a variety of sensory resources in a calm relaxed environment.

Movers and Shakers @ Binbrook Children's Centre - Movers and Shakers is a fun music and movement session which supports and develops children's communication and physical skills. The session includes using musical instruments and singing to support early language development and physical activities such as scarves, bubbles, balls and parachute games to develop co-ordination and physical awareness.

Stay & Play for under 1's @ Binbrook Children's Centre - This session aims to support developing babies to grow and learn. Activities will encourage babies to reach their developmental milestones, following their interests and curiosities.

Quiet Time - Quiet time opportunities are available for families to use the Children's Centre resources on a small group or 1:1 basis. Call your local Children's Centre to find out more.

Skills Development - Our skills development service works with parents who want to make positive changes for themselves and their families. The service offers encouragement and practical support with trying new things and getting more involved, often leading to Learning, Training, Volunteering and Employment. Ask at the centre for more information.
