About the fund

As the country, and more specifically the sport and physical activity sector continues to battle with Covid-19, we are turning our focus to recovery and revival. The disruption the pandemic has had on sports clubs and physical activity groups has been unprecedented with 'Return to Play' being halted again before it really had chance to set in for many.

Active Lincolnshire have re-allocated funds to develop the Lincolnshire Club Revival Fund which aims to support clubs and groups in reviving their club/group activities as soon as rules and guidelines allow them to do so.

Who can apply

Any sports club, physical activity group operating in Lincolnshire whose regular sessions have been affected by the pandemic can apply for the fund. The club or group must have been in operation for at least 12 months prior to the pandemic (pre-March 2020) and *must not* be in receipt of the Sport England Community Emergency Fund awarded throughout 2020.

What we will fund

The fund can be used for any of the following; if you require funding for something not listed please contact us and we will be happy to have a chat about your requirements to see if they can be funded.

- CPD & upskilling
- Sports Equipment
- Safety Equipment
- Facility hire
- Re-start promotion

How much we will fund

Awards will be between £100 - £1,000 per club. This is a limited pot of money and will be awarded on a case by case basis.

How to apply

The application process is short and simple requiring completion of a proposal form detailing what the funding will be used for, intended outcomes and some specific information about your club or group and its membership.
